



## Dog Daycare, Lodging, Grooming, & Training

**Welcome to Camp Canine!** Camp Canine is a fun adventure for your dog and their safety is our first priority. This is a bit of information about how our facility operates and cares for your furry family member.

### General

**Collars and Leashes:** Please keep your dog on a leash while entering or leaving our facility. Do not allow your dog to approach other dogs or people. All dogs on the premises may not be dog friendly and behaviors can be influenced by being on leash and with their owners. All collars and leashes are removed once the dog is secure in our premises.

### Lodging

During your dogs stay, our facility offers Doggie Daycare for eligible, active, and social dogs. They will get lots of exercise, make new friends, and go home very sleepy if they participate in daycare. (We retain the right to remove a dog from the daycare program at any time.) Please refer to the Daycare Sheet for more detailed information. We also take dogs that are not dog friendly or eligible for the daycare program. Please read the following information to determine if our environment is right for your dog. Keep in mind that when you signed your Pet Profile, you acknowledged that you are responsible for any expenses your dog incurs while at Camp Canine.

**Accommodations:** We utilize private camp sites for overnights versus a 'cage free' environment. Dogs that spend 24 hours a day interacting with lots of other dogs spend a tremendous amount of time in an aroused state. Even the "happy arousal" that results from good, clean, play can take an emotional and physical toll on a dog over time. For most dogs, as their level of tiredness increases, their tolerance decreases, making them more prone to scuffles or even full-blown fights with other dogs. We like to give our dogs a chance to unwind and get good nights sleep at the end of a long day at play in their own area with their own personal belongings. They get to snuggle up with their belongings and are serenaded by 100.5 each night while they sleep. All dishes are sanitized and there is an air sanitation system installed in our building.

**Schedule:** Our business hours are 7:00am - 6:30pm Mon – Fri. During these hours dogs must be dropped off by 10am to play in our daycare program and no later than 5pm to stay the night. Pick up's and drop off's on Saturday and Sunday by appointment only from 7-9am & 4-6pm. Upon drop off, we will review your scheduled pick up time. If you decide to change that time, you **MUST** call and let us know.

**Please make us aware:** Of any recent issues or illnesses your dog may be experiencing. Tell us if there are any lumps, bumps, scrapes or sores on your dog. If there are any behaviors or conditions your dog may experience while under stress or while they have boarded previously. We will review in detail any medications that you have brought for your dog's stay.

**Food / Belongings:** We recommend that you bring your dog's regular food when he/she stays with us. Remember changing your dog's routine does cause stress and changing their food can add further stress to their digestive system. If your dog is here for a longer stay, and is participating in our daycare program you may want to increase the amount you normally give due to the extra activity. Also for picky eaters you may want to bring something to add to their food to entice them to eat: moist treats, parmesan cheese, or canned food.

You are welcome to bring bedding, toys and special treats for your dog to help them feel more comfortable. If this is the first time your dog is boarding, you may even want to bring an item of clothing that has your scent to make your dog feel more relaxed. Please be aware that anything you bring to put in the camp site may be ruined. (Dogs sometimes need a night to adjust to their new routine or on occasion a dog may also play with and destroy items in their kennel.)

Please do not bring bowls for your dog (unless there is a special need). We provide stainless steel bowls for their food and water. We will not put rawhides or anything we feel may be a choking hazard into your dog's camp site. Please be aware that different surroundings can cause a change in regular habits such as eating, drinking, bowel movements and urination.

**Additional Lodging Services:** You can also add on Cuddle Sessions, Play Sessions, Walks, additional potty breaks or Kong's to your dog's stay. We also offer treadmill sessions. We do not charge for the training that is required to have your dog run on the treadmill. You will just need to pay for the sessions.

**Additional Information:** If your dog stays with us for 7 nights or more, they are entitled to a free bath\* before they leave. (\*Free bath does not include nail trim or cleaning of the ears.)

**Grooming Services:** The items listed below can be scheduled by making an appointment or they can be combined with your dog's stay.

- Full Service Grooming (cut or trim fur) and includes nail trim and cleaning and/or plucking of the ear
- Deshedding treatment
- Bath includes nail trim and cleaning of the outer ear area
- Nail trim only (cut or dremmel)
- Anal glands
- Brushing teeth
- Specialty shampoos (Oatmeal for dry skin or Tea Tree Oil for hot spots)
- Brush or blow outs

**After the stay:** We try not to feed dogs close to their pick up time to ensure there are no digestive issues due to the excitement of going home (seeing you and the car ride). We will let you know at pick up if your dog needs to still be fed. Please wait a few hours before feeding your dog upon their return home. Your dog(s) will be very thirsty and tired from the excitement of their stay. Give minimal water after returning home. After longer stays, it is normal for it to take a couple days for your dog to fully recover from all the activity of their stay. Please contact us and let us know if you have any issues or concerns after your stay.
